

Job Title: **Theater Worker**

Work Conditions Pathway: INDOORS/LIGHT WORK/INTERACT WITH PUBLIC (Disk 6)

Occupational Outlook Handbook Information

Nature of Work: Theater workers collect admission tickets and passes from patrons. They assist in finding seats, searching for lost articles, and locating such facilities as rest rooms and telephones. They may also fill patrons' orders at concession stands, monitor film reels, and clean up the seating, lobby, and concession areas.

Working Conditions: No information available.

Employment Outlook: The projected 1998-2008 employment change is average compared with all occupations.

Earnings: No information available.

Training, Qualifications, and Advancement: The most common type of training for theater workers is short-term, on-the-job training. No formal qualifications are required. Opportunity for advancement is limited.

1. Sell goods and provide services to guests
2. Sell admission tickets and passes
3. Collect tickets from guests
4. Direct guests to seats
5. Fill food and drink orders
6. Stock food counter with supplies
7. Gather trash from theater seating area
8. Use a broom and a vacuum to clean floors
9. Set up and monitor projection, lighting, and sound equipment

Related Occupations: Arcade workers, amusement park attendants, concession or security staff at sports events or concerts, and recreation assistants.
